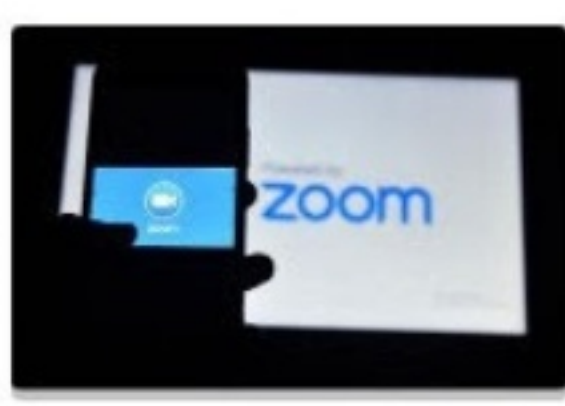
Ireland's first academic research centre dedicated to research, policy and education on corruption and anti-corruption has been established at **Dublin City University (DCU)**.
