The School of Internal Security and SMART offers various Academic and Research programme i.e. Ph.D. in Police Studies/Security Studies/Disaster Management; M.A. in Police Administration & Strategic Management (MAPA&SM); M.A./Msc in Disaster Management and National Security (MA/MScDMNS); MTech in Disaster Management and National Security (MTechDMNS); Post Graduate Diploma in Police Science and Management (PGDIPSM); Post Graduate Diploma in Police Administration (PGDPA); Bachelor of Arts in Security Management (BASM) & Diploma in Police Science (DIPS). Field visits, internships with major police and security organizations are a regular feature of the school. In addition, seminars, special lectures and regular interaction with practitioners from all domains of internal security are facilitated by the school.

In addition, the school has Five dedicated Centers namely the Centre for Border Management and Intelligence Studies (CBMIS); Centre for Counter Insurgency and Counter Terrorism (CCICT); Centre for Traffic Management and Road Safety (CTMRS); Centre for Women in Police and Security Services (CW PSS), and Centre for Disaster Risk Reduction (CDRR).

Masters Program (M.Tech./MA/M.Sc.) in Disaster Management and National Security

According to statistics, India witnessed more than 3,600 disasters between 1980 and 2023, affecting around 1.6 billion people and causing significant economic losses considered as a serious threat to national security. Moreover, the frequency and intensity of disasters are increasing due to factors like climate change and rapid urbanization that hits almost all parts of Indian geographies.

Thus, by equipping citizens with knowledge and skills in disaster management and national security, such as emergency preparedness, technical enhancement, response protocols, and community-based initiatives, India can significantly reduce the adverse effects of disasters and build a safer, more resilient society for all its inhabitants.

With this motivation, School of Internal Security and SMART Policing at Rashtriya Raksha University, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, comes with two unique masters programmes in the field of Disaster Management and National Security as per contemporary needs and with state-of-the-art facilities.



Master of Technology (M.Tech.) in Disaster Management and National Security

The objective of the Master of Technology (M.Tech.) in Disaster Management and National Security is to provide students with advanced technological expertise and strategic insights necessary for addressing contemporary challenges in disaster management and national security. The course is a 2-year full-time residential programme with 4 semesters. The first year of the course or first two semesters are dedicated to study from the fundamentals of disaster, advanced technologies in disaster, to disaster governance by eminent national and international faculties, whereas last two semesters or final year of the study is entirely on internship and dissertation activities according to his/her interest and national needs.

Master of Arts/Master of Science (MA/M.SC) in Disaster Management and National Security

The objective of the Master of Arts/Master of Science (MA/M.SC) in Disaster Management and National Security is to equip students with comprehensive knowledge, critical skills, and strategic perspectives essential for effectively addressing and managing disasters, emergencies, and security challenges at local, national, and international levels. This interdisciplinary program aims to foster analytical thinking, decision-making proficiency, and leadership capabilities to prepare graduates for key roles in disaster response, risk mitigation, and national security, contributing to resilient and secure communities globally. The course is a 2-year full-time residential programme with 4 semesters. The first two semesters of the first year of the course are dedicated to study from the fundamentals of disaster, advanced technologies in disaster, to disaster governance by eminent national and international faculties, whereas from 3rd semester one can choose his/her specialization (Specialization offers: Sustainable Development and Disaster Management; Technologies in Disaster Management; National Security and Disaster Management). The final semester of the study is entirely based on internship and dissertation activities according to his/her interest of specialization and national needs.

PhD in Disaster Management

Objective:

The objective of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Disaster Management is to advance scholarly research and contribute to the academic understanding of disaster-related phenomena. This program aims to cultivate highly skilled researchers and thought leaders who will generate new knowledge, theories, and methodologies in the field of disaster management. Doctoral candidates will engage in rigorous investigation, critical analysis, and the development of innovative solutions to address complex challenges associated with natural and man-made disasters. The Ph.D. in Disaster Management seeks to produce experts who will contribute significantly to the advancement of global resilience, policy formulation, and effective strategies for mitigating the impact of disasters on communities and enhancing overall disaster preparedness and response capabilities.

Selection Process:

Through Entrance Examination and Interview for Regular Mode. No Entrance for Practitioners Mode.

Programme Fee Yearly:

80,000/- (Regular Mode) & 120,000/- (Practitioners Mode)

Eligibility (Regular Mode):

Master's degree in respective discipline or equivalent with 55% (equivalent to CGPA 5.5 on 10-point scale). However, for candidates belonging to SC/ST category, women and persons with different abilities, the eligibility shall be 50% (equivalent to CGPA 5.0 on 10-point scale) in master's degree or M. Phil or equivalent degree in relevant discipline awarded by recognized university in India or Abroad or Four-year B.E./ B.Tech. with CGPA 6.0 or equivalent.

Eligibility (Practitioners Mode):

Master's degree in respective discipline.

Candidates are required to have a minimum of 15 years of professional experience. Applicants should be serving or retired individuals from armed forces, central armed police forces, state police organizations, central police organizations, security and defence industries.

No Fellowship will be provided in practitioners mode.
