RCET Guidelines for the Academic Year 2025 -2026

1 Title and Commencement of the Policy:

- 1.1 These guidelines may be called “The Rashtriya Raksha University RCET Guidelines, 2025-.
- 1.2 These guidelines shall be applicable for admission in the programmes being offered at **RRU, Gujarat Campuse** for the academic year **2025-26**.

2 All vacant seats except reserved for SC/ST will be converted to Un-reserved seats. When Open Admission will be announced against the vacant seats after the regular admissions.

2.1 Instructions for B.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering with Specialization in Cyber Security / Electronics Engineering (VLSI Design and Technology) and M.Tech in Cyber Security / in Data Science & Machine Learning / in Disaster Management & National Security.

2.2 In case of Bachelor of Technology in Computer Science with Specialization in Cyber Security, preference will be given to successful candidates in **JEE (Mains)** with **JEE Score** as the grading in deciding merit. If seats remain vacant after this, Vacant seats will be offered to candidates with **RCET 2025 score** as per the criteria as mentioned above. The Candidate who would like to apply for B.Tech may also appear in RCET 2025.

2.3 In the case of Master of Technology in Computer Science with Specialization in Cyber Security, preference will be given to candidates with valid **GATE** scores of **50%** and above, with a **GATE** score as the grading in deciding the merit. If seats remain vacant after this, Vacant seats will be offered to candidates with **RCET 2025 score** as per the criteria as mentioned above. The Candidate who would like to apply for M.Tech can also appear in RCET 2025.

2.4 BPES: The weighting of marks for BPES will be evenly divided between RCET and Sports Achievement, with each accounting for 50%.

Highest achievement/participation certificate should be uploaded (Mandatory).

- (i) All such candidates who have represented India in any International Championship such as the Olympic Games, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, South Asian Games, Junior or Senior: World Championships, World Cups, Asian Championships, or Asian Cups will be granted 25 marks in this category. Representation shall be considered in such games/ sports that are approved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS). The certificate will be considered for only those sports whose federation was approved by MYAS.

For the PGDSC program, the RCET test procedure will remain the same.

2 RCET (UG) 2025 Eligibility:

- 2.5 Candidates wishing to appear for the RCET 2025 exam must fulfil the eligibility criteria set by the Rashtriya Raksha University as follows:
- 2.6 Candidates must have passed 10+2 with a minimum 50% marks as aggregate (45% of SC/ ST candidates, 40 % for Kashmiri migrants)
- 2.7 Candidates must have a relevant subject in 10+2 to apply for any respective course.
- 2.8 Candidates shall be Indian citizens to appear for the RCET exam.
- 2.9 Candidates from Bhutan & Nepal are also allowed to appear for the RCET exam.
- 2.10 There is no age limit to appear for the RCET exam.
- 2.11 The number of attempts for candidate is unrestricted. Candidates may appear for the exam as many times as desired as long as they meet all other qualifying conditions.
- 2.12 There shall be no negative marking for RCET-UG 2025 exam.

3 RCET (PG) Eligibility 2025

Candidates wishing to appear for the RCET 2025 exam must fulfil the eligibility criteria as per CUET (PG) conducted by NTA.

- Candidates must have passed graduation with a minimum 50% marks as aggregate (45% of SC/ ST candidates, 40 % for Kashmiri migrants)
- Candidates shall have a relevant subject in graduation to apply for any respective course.
- Candidates must be Indian citizens to appear for the RCET exam.
- Candidates from Bhutan & Nepal are also allowed to appear for the exam.
- There is no upper age limit to appear for the RCET exam.
- The number of attempts for a candidate is unrestricted. Candidates may appear for the
- RCET exam as many times as desired as long as they meet all other qualifying conditions.
- There shall be no negative marking for RCET-PG 2025 exam

4 RCET Admit Card 2025

5 Guidelines for RCET candidates

- 5.5 Students must adhere to the set procedure in tune with the guidelines issued to them from time to time.
- 5.6 It shall be the sole responsibility of the student/candidate to complete all the condition/documents/requirement /issued/desired by admission committee
- 5.7 Candidates are advised to visit the RRU website www.rru.ac.in regularly for an update regarding admission
- 5.8 Only written correspondence via email shall only be entertained for any matter related to admission.
- 5.9 The University reserves right to call off any program which does not meet the criteria of minimum number of admissions, which is 20% per course, except MPhil (RCI) and PhD, or run the program with modified academic schedule, Fees submission in such program are subject to the approval of the Admission Committee.
- 5.10 All vacant seats except reserved for SC/ST will be converted to UR seats. Open Admission will be announced against the vacant seats after the regular admissions.

6 Nature of Admission

- 6.5 Admissions will be offered online and shall be treated as provisional only subject to verification of documents and deposit of fees. No Candidate can claim this offer as a right to get an admission.
- 6.6 Students must have to provide all original documents which were uploaded during the time of application at the time of physical verification.
- 6.7 If a student fails to submit any document sought by the University, the admission shall be treated as cancelled and all the rights regarding admission shall be vested in the Admission Committee of RRU.



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7 Removal of difficulty

In case of any dispute regarding admission, the decision of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Chairperson, Admission Committee, RRU shall be final and binding to everyone.
