RRU Scholarship Guidelines

1. Purpose

The Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU) Scholarship is designed to provide financial assistance and encourage meritorious students to pursue their academic goals in security, defence, and strategic studies. The scholarship aims to promote educational excellence and assist deserving students in fulfilling their aspirations, particularly those who exhibit exceptional academic performance, leadership qualities, and a commitment to contributing to the field of national security and defence.

2. Categories of Scholarships

The University offers a range of scholarships to support students in various programs:

- **Merit-based Scholarships:** For students with exceptional academic performance.
- **Need-based Scholarships:** For students from economically weaker sections.

3. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the RRU Scholarship, students must fulfil the following criteria:

- **Merit-based Scholarships:**
 - Undergraduate and Postgraduate students with a minimum of 70% marks in the qualifying examination i.e., RCET/GATE/CLAT. *(For 1st year only)*
 - Consistent academic excellence throughout previous studies. *(For 02nd year to till the end of the Programme)*
- **Need-based Scholarships:**
 - Proof of family income (Income certificate issued by a competent authority).
 - Family income should not exceed ₹5,00,000 per annum.

4. Application Process

- Students must submit the scholarship application form available on the University's official website.
- **Required documents:**
 - Mark sheets or grade reports from previous academic years.
 - Income certificate (for need-based scholarships).



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- The application form must be submitted by the specified deadline each academic year.

5. Selection Process

- A Scholarship Selection Committee will review all applications.
- Selection will be based on merit and financial need.
- Shortlisted candidates may be called for an interview, if required.

6. Scholarship Disbursement Criteria for UG and PG Students (*For 1st year only*)

Eligibility:

1. The candidate must qualify for the **Rashtriya Raksha University Common Entrance Test (RCET)**.
2. For Undergraduate (UG) students:
 - a. Must have achieved **70% or above** in their 12th-grade board examinations.
3. For Postgraduate (PG) students:
 - a. Must have scored a minimum of **60% aggregate** or an equivalent grade in their UG degree.

Disbursement:

1. 10% of the total fee collected by Schools will be given as Scholarship to the students.
2. 20% of the student from each batch of the respective School, based on their performance, will be eligible for the scholarship.
3. Scholarship will be provided as a stipend, subject to university norms and availability of funds.
4. Disbursement will occur on yearly basis after the declaration of results and verification of academic performance.

Continuation of Scholarship: (*For 02nd year to till the end of the Programme*)

1. Students must maintain a **Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 7.0 or above** in every semester examination throughout their academic program.
2. Scholarship benefits will be reviewed semester-wise. If the CGPA falls below 7.0 in any semester:
 - a. The student will receive a **one-semester probation period** to improve their performance.
 - b. Failure to meet the CGPA criteria after the probation period will result in the suspension of the scholarship.



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3. Priority may be given to students from economically weaker sections, provided they meet the above academic requirements.

7. Conditions for Withdrawal or Cancellation

The scholarship may be withdrawn or cancelled under the following conditions:

1. Failure to maintain the required academic standards.
2. Misrepresentation of information in the application process.
3. Students found involved in disciplinary issues or academic malpractice will forfeit their scholarship immediately.

8. Important Dates

- Scholarship application opens: Commencement of classes starting of session (**In accordance with the Academic Calendar**)
- Deadline for submission: **With in one month of commencement of classes.**
- Announcement of selected candidates: After result declaration of 1st session (**In accordance with the Academic Calendar**)

9. Removal of difficulties

- Any difficulty faced during the implementation of the scholarship guidelines shall be brought to the attention of the University Dean, who will document the issue in detail.
- The University reserves the right to modify or revoke the scholarship if any discrepancies or violations are found.
- A formal meeting of **Pro Vice Chancellor, Registrar and University Dean** shall be convened to discuss the issue if raised.
- Based on deliberations, appropriate guidance, clarification, or corrective measures will be recommended by the officials.
